- Around *mid-February 2024*, shortlisted applicants have to submit either a Visual Arts Portfolio (for VA applicants) or a 1-minute Sport Skills Video (for PE applicants). More details will be disclosed to shortlisted applicants in due course.

- A second interview will be arranged for the finalists in March 2024. Parents will be invited to accompany the • applicant on the date of the second interview where they may also be interviewed.
