General Information

School Mission

Territory-wide Recruitment

• Students of Jockey Club Ti-I College are recruited on a territory-wide basis with full autonomy (i.e. 100% discretionary placement).

• The running of the Dormitory not only helps students save time in commuting from home to school, but also provides them with an all-round school life. If admitted, interested students should make an application for a boarding place and go through a selection process.

Secondary School Place Allocation

• Application for our school will **NOT** hamper applicant's right for Secondary School Place Allocation.

Attachment to the Application Form

Applicants should attach the following to the application form:

- copies of all available primary five and six *report cards;
- a copy of the HK Permanent Identity Card or HK Identity Card with a Land Slip or HK Birth Certificate;
- a copy of the Primary Six Student Record Form issued by the EDB;
- a non-refundable application fee of HK\$75 by cash or in a crossed cheque payable to 'The Incorporated Management
 Committee of Jockey Club Ti-I College'. The name of the applicant should be written on the back of the cheque; and,
- copies of *supporting documents (if any).

Deadline of Submission

• The application form should be submitted together with the attachments (see above) to our school in person, or sent to our school by mail (with a stamped return envelope) within the period *from 2 January to 20 January 2026 inclusively*.

Visual Arts Portfolio/1-minute Sport Skills Video

- Around mid-February 2026, shortlisted applicants have to submit either a Visual Arts Portfolio (for VA applicants) or a
 1-minute Sport Skills Video (for PE applicants). More details will be disclosed to shortlisted applicants in due course.

- o aesthetics sense
- o variety of capabilities in creations
- curiosity and active engagement in the visual arts community
- The 1-minute Sport Skills Video should demonstrate your
- skill level, technique and abilities (at least 30 seconds)
- interest and capacities
- potential in sport

^{*}Applicants should submit the original or verified version of report cards and other supporting documents for verification. The grading criteria (e.g. percentages of students getting different grades) should be stated on the report cards for reference.

Practical Test and Interviews

- Shortlisted applicants will be invited to attend a practical test and first interview on Saturday, 28 February 2026.
- A second interview will be arranged for the finalists in *March 2026*. Parents will be invited to accompany the applicant on the date of the second interview where they may also be interviewed.

Admission Results

- Successful applicants will be notified individually on 31 March 2026.
- Secondary School Places Allocation (SSPA) results will be officially released by the Education Bureau on *7 July 2026*.
