General Information

School Mission

- The school was founded with the belief that on top of the normal grammar school curriculum, it can also give students a better chance to develop their potential in sports or arts.
- The school puts equal emphasis on academic achievement and the development of students' talents in sports and arts.
- By the time students leave the school, they will have acquired proficient language skills, have an analytical mind, the ability to think for themselves, and a sound knowledge in academic subjects as well as in sports or arts.

Dormitory

Attachments to the Application Form

Applicants should attach the following to the application form:

- copies of **all available *report cards** of 2024-2025 and 2025-2026;
- a copy of the **HK Permanent Identity Card** or **HK Identity Card with a Land Slip** or **HK Birth Certificate**;
- a non-refundable application fee of HK\$75 by cash or in a crossed cheque payable to '**The Incorporated Management Committee of Jockey Club Ti-I College**' with the name of the applicant written on the back of the cheque;
- a stamped self-addressed envelope; and,
- copies of *supporting documents (if any).

*Applicants should submit the original or verified version of report cards and other supporting documents for verification. The grading criteria (e.g. percentages of students getting different grades) should be stated on the report cards for reference.

 - talent in visual arts
 - aesthetics sense
 - variety of capabilities in creations
 - curiosity and active engagement in visual arts learning/ community
- The Sport Skills Video should demonstrate your
 - skill level, technique and abilities
 - interest and capacities
 - potential in sports

Deadline of Submission

- The application form should be submitted together with the attachments (see above) to our school in person, or sent to our school by mail. The application will be processed upon the receipt of all the documents as well as the online material **by 2:00 pm on 20 May 2026**.

Practical Test and Interview

- Shortlisted applicants may be invited to attend a practical test and interview in **June 2026**. Parents will be invited to accompany the applicant on the date of the interview where they may also be interviewed.

"Visual Arts Portfolio" Submission Guidelines
(For VA Applicants Only)

General Information

The Portfolio is a selection of the applicant's recent creative works from the past three years that reflect your strength in creative practice. The selection you make for the portfolio should include a wide range of media, demonstrating your own ideas, interests, enthusiasm and ambition in visual arts.

The Visual Arts Portfolio should demonstrate your

- talent in visual arts
- aesthetic sense
- variety of capabilities in creations
- curiosity and active engagement in visual arts learning /community

Tips for the Visual Arts Portfolio

The Portfolio should be in PDF format and contain your visual arts-related works. It can be a documentation of your personal creative practice, including works selected from your school projects, or personal works in any arts/design disciplines, such as drawing, painting, photography, mixed media, sculpture, installation, video, animation, fashion, graphics, product design, etc. The total number of pages must not exceed 10 pages and the maximum file size is 300 MB. The contents of your portfolio should reflect your ability, personality, creativity, and potential in studying visual arts.

- Show your works executed with a variety of media and approaches, rather than many works of the same kind. Sketches from idea development also can be included.
- Personal insights and creative concepts are emphasized, not only sheer technical virtuosity.
- You may include both two- and three-dimensional works, as well as interactive and time-based projects. Please provide links to the actual websites and video files if they are accessible online.
- Include the title, the year of creation and an approximately 30-word description for each work. Please consider the image size and order of how these works should be viewed.

Content of the Visual Arts Portfolio (For reference only)

Item 1 - Images of your original artwork (4-6 pages)

Item 2 - Selected photos and descriptions of art activity participation/ art awards (1-2 pages) (if any)

Item 3 - Create a portrait painting of how you see yourself or others see you. There is no limitation on media and ways of expression. Provide an artist statement of about 50 words. (1 page)

Item 4 - Create a 3D sculpture from found objects or materials. Create a message by exploring its colors, forms and materials. Photograph it and provide an artist statement of about 50 words. (1 page)

"Sport Skills Video" Submission Guidelines
(For PE Applicants Only)

General Information

Skill proficiency is decisive in determining the outcomes of many sports. For the purpose of talent identification, the skill performance of the athlete is usually assessed. Therefore, it is necessary for applicants to submit a video to demonstrate their sport skills.

The video should demonstrate your

- skill level, techniques and abilities
- interest and capacities
- potential in sports

Tips for the video

It is important to assess the applicant's performance in a fair and unbiased manner, thus,

- the appearance of the applicant should be clearly seen in the video; and
- the video clips of applicant's sport-specific actions or game footage should demonstrate his/her talents, technical abilities and mastery of a key sport skill.

Content of the video (1 minute)

Skill Performance

- The skill shown in the video should demonstrate the skill selected in the application form.
- The video should contain specific skill performance in training/ competition/ time trial in events like swimming (strokes) or athletics (track events etc.). Related records should be clearly seen (if any).
